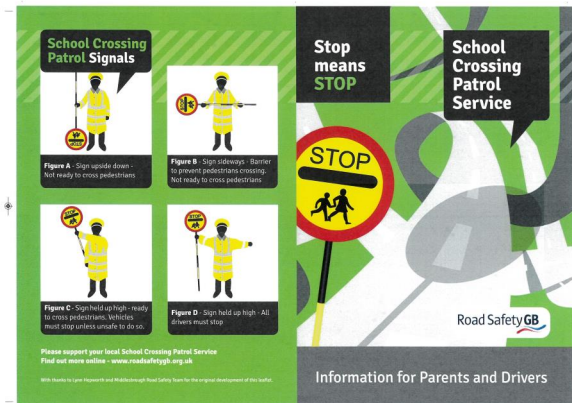
No need to pre-book this lunch, children can choose on the day. Please send in a home packed lunch if your child does not wish to have the Christmas lunch.
